

PARIS OLYMPICS 2024



The 2024 Summer Olympics will take place from 26 July to 11 August 2024 in France, with some competitions starting on 24 July.

Paris is the main host city this year. Paris will become the second city ever to host the Summer Olympics three times, having previously hosted in 1900 and 1924. London is the first city to host the Summer Olympics three times and has hosted the Games in the years 1908, 1948 and 2012.

SPORTS

The programme of the 2024 Summer Olympics will feature 329 events in 32 sports.

Paris 2024 will feature the debut of breakdancing as an Olympic event.

EMBLEM

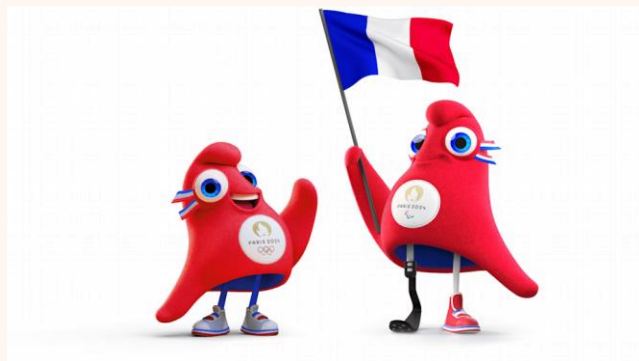


The emblem for the 2024 Summer Olympics is a representation of Marianne, the national personification of France.

The emblem also resembles a gold medal. The use of a female figure also serves as an homage to the 1900 Summer Olympics in Paris, which were the first to allow women to participate. It is also the first time in history the same emblem has been used for both the Olympic Games and the Paralympic Games.

MASCOT



The name of the Paris 2024 mascot is Olympic Phryge. The mascots are shaped after the traditional small Phrygian hats that. The Phrygian hat is a historic French symbol of freedom and liberty.

The Olympic Phryge is decked out in blue, white and red which are the colours of France's national flag along with the Paris 2024 logo shown across its chest.

The motto of the Olympic Phryge and Paralympic Phryge is: "Alone we go faster, but together we go further".
